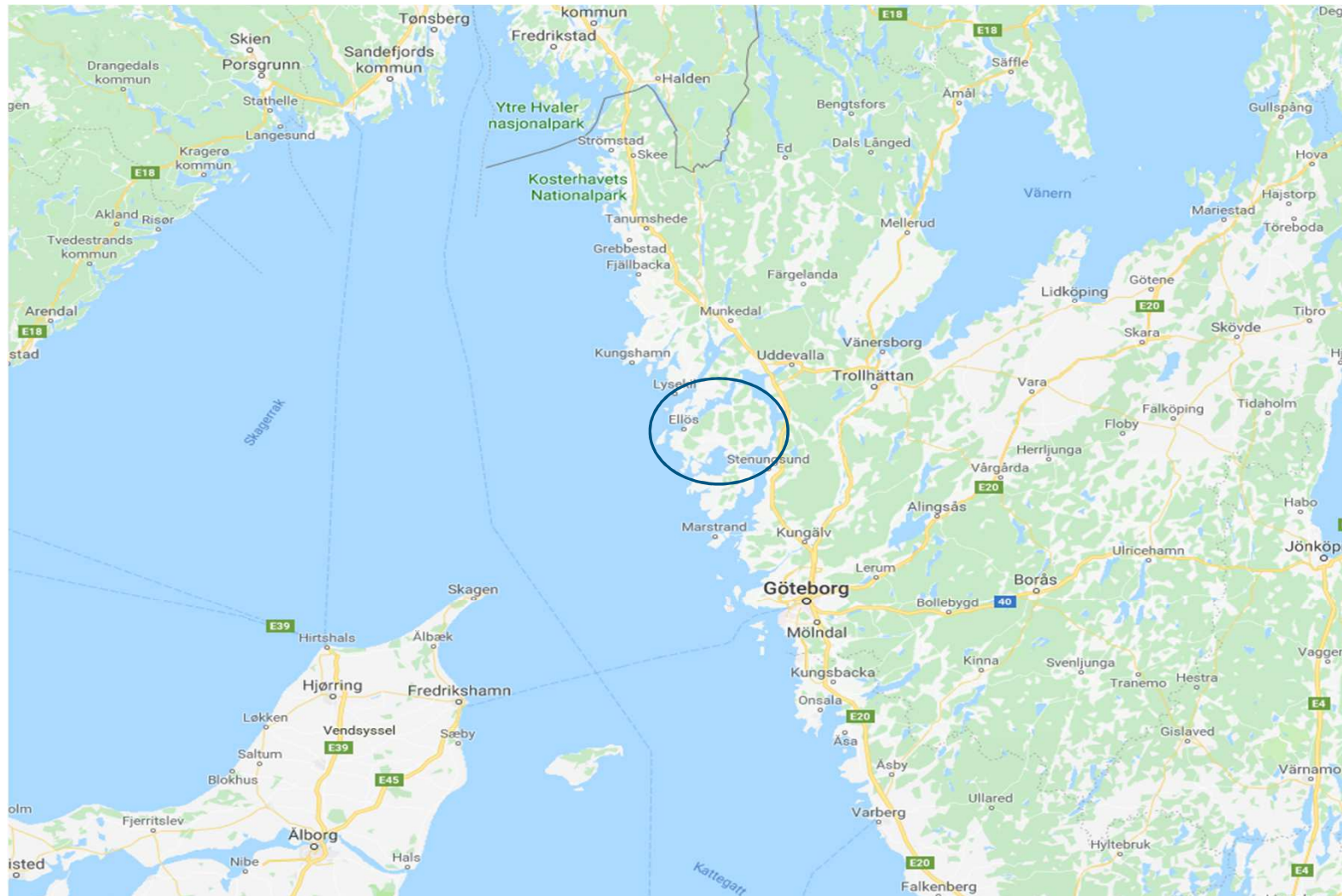

Facts about Orust

- Orust is Swedens third largest island
- Approximately 15 100 inhabitants
 - Tripple that sum in the summer
 - More than 5 000 summer houses
- Som of Bohuslän Countys most famous sites
 - Kåringön, Mollösund, Gullholmen
- Famuos for the the produktion of sailboats



Islands and Small towns/villages

- The municipality contains of 1 670 islands such as Kåringön, Gullholmen och Flatön
- Small towns/villages are Henån, Svanesund, Ellös och Varekil
- Two bridges and 5 ferry lines



Statistics

- 1 200 commute to work in Orust
- 3 300 commute to work in other places outside Orust
- 3 950 live and work in the municipality
- 3.6 % is the unemployment rate in the age group 16-64 years
- 4.1 % 18-24 years

Commuting and enterprises

- 70 % commute to the south, mainly to Göteborg and Stenungsund
- More people commute to Orust from north of the island
- There are some 2 000 enterprises on Orust

- Municipality assembly 41 members
- Municipal executive committee
- Executive sub-committees for education, social welfare, etc.
- Environment and building committee
- Some 1 100 employees
- Budget 2018: 1.1 billion SEK

- Worldwide reputation

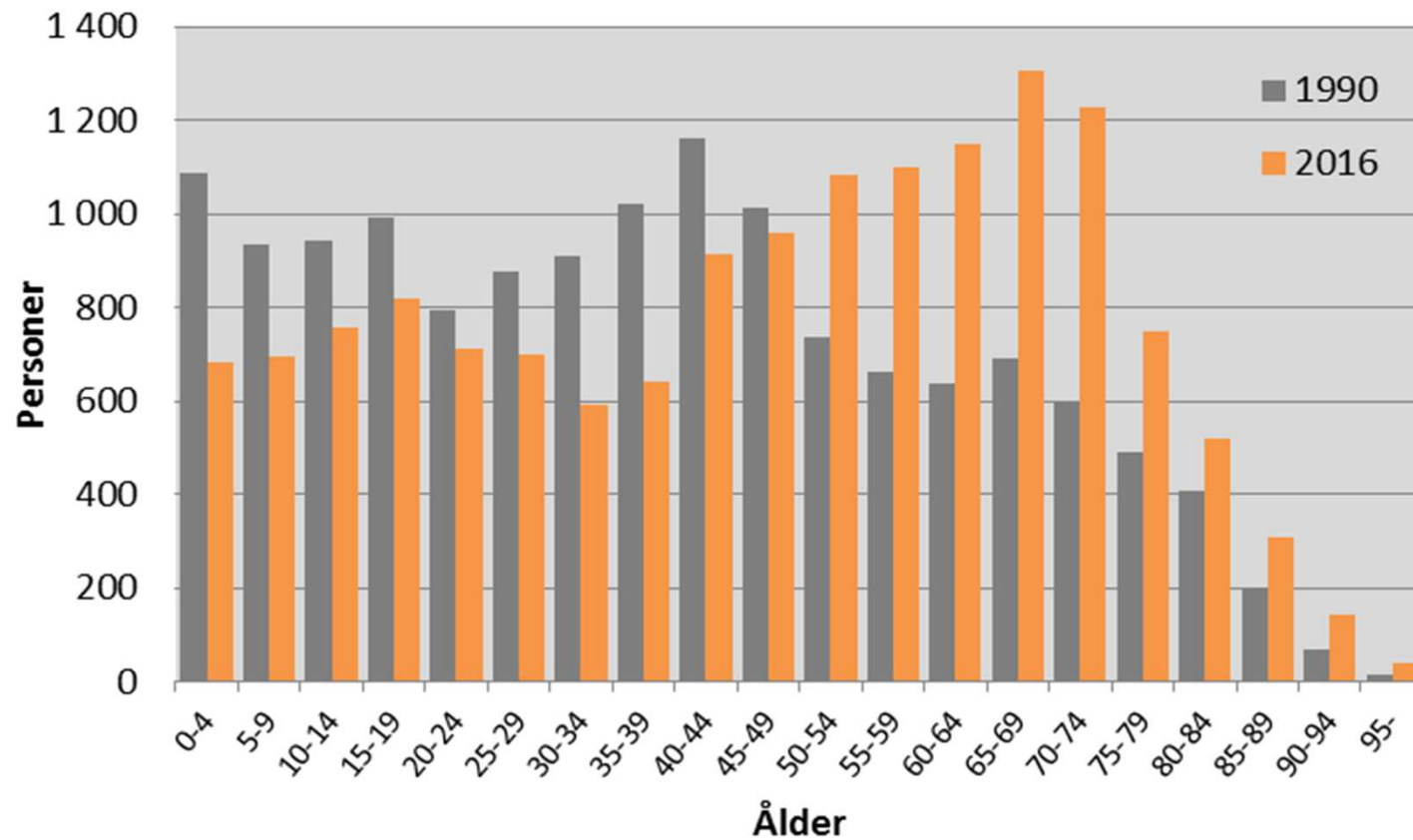


Our surroundings

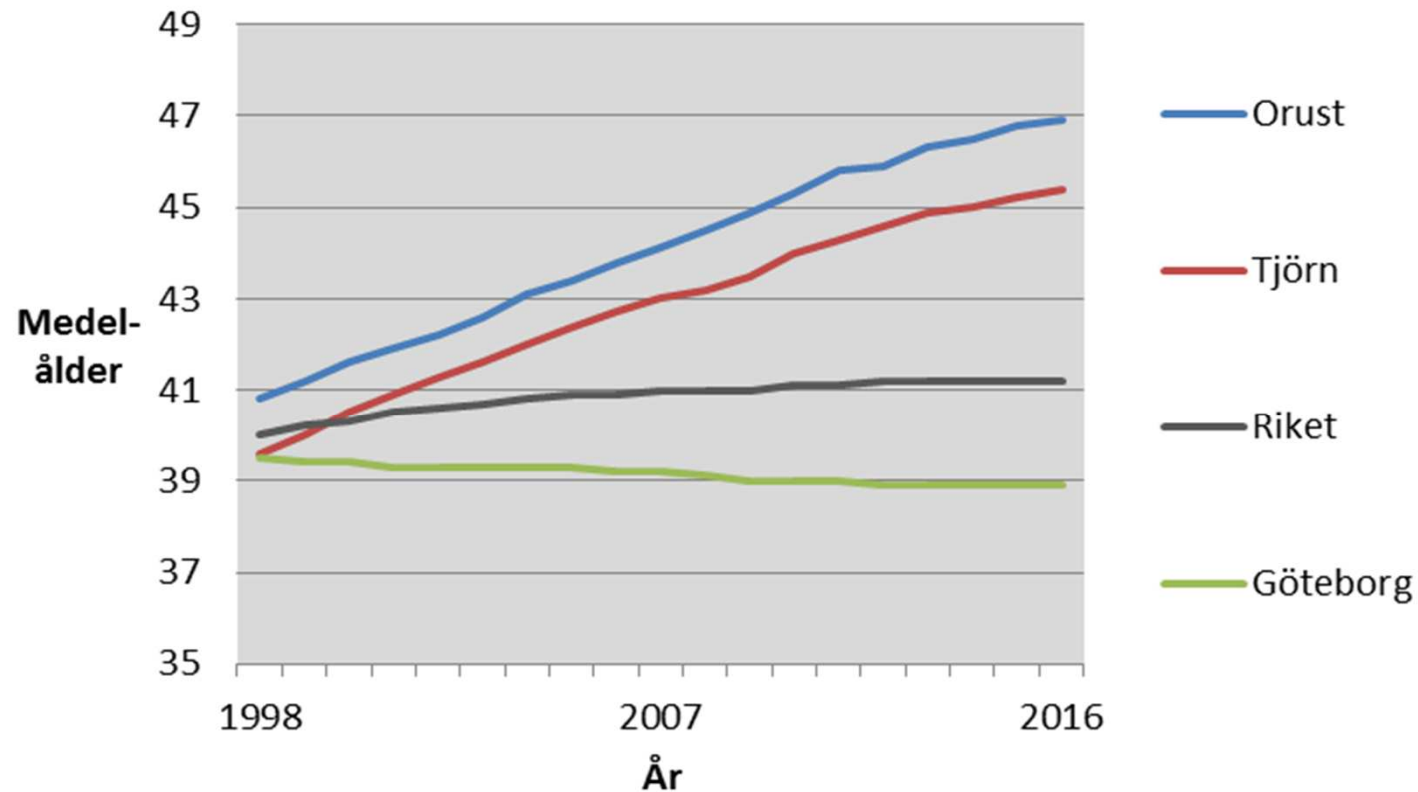
- growth regions becomes more important in an aging western world

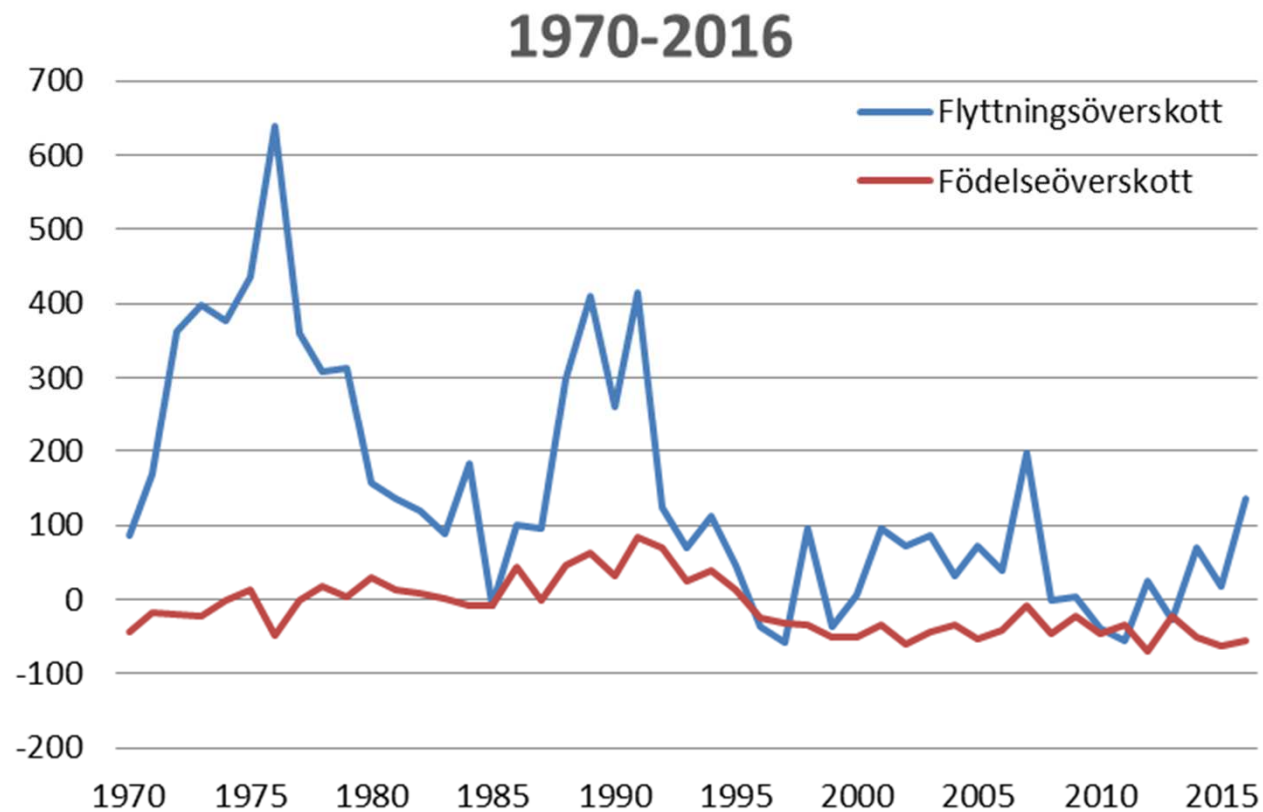
Population 1990-2016



Average age of the population

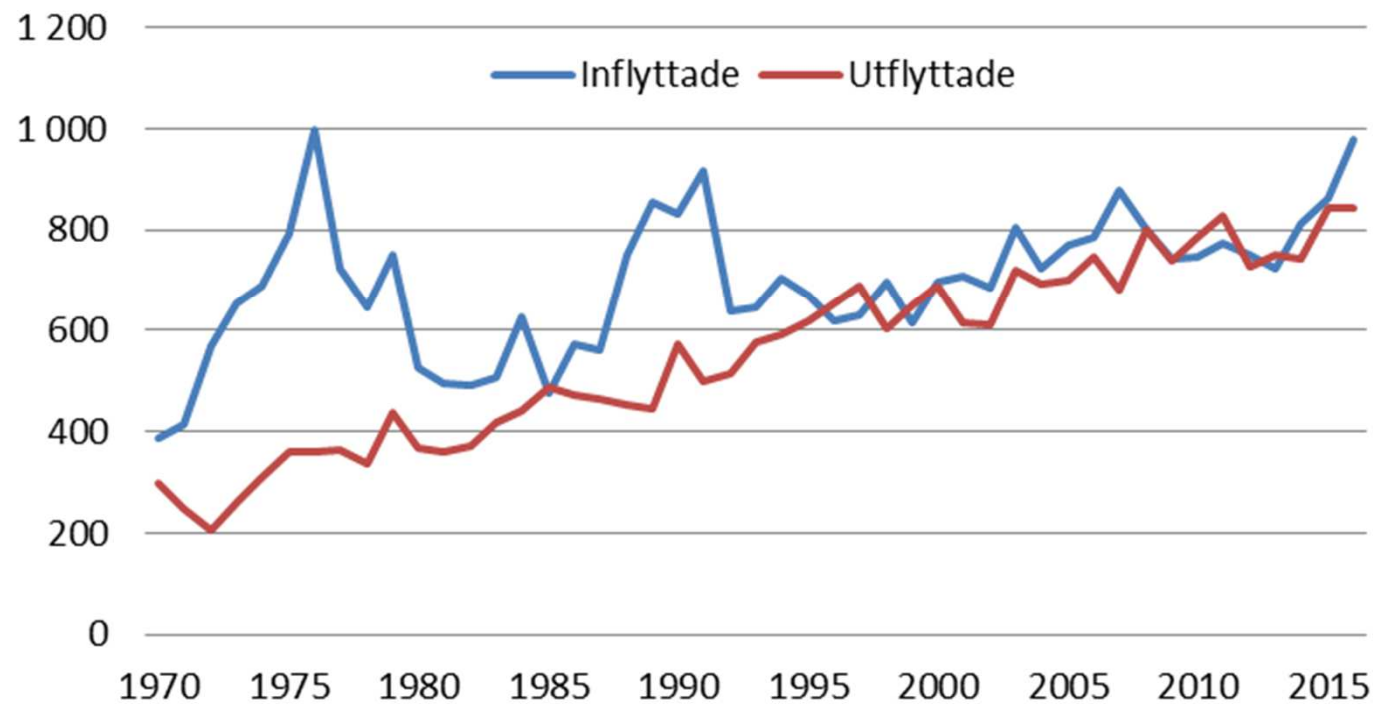


Surplus of births and moves

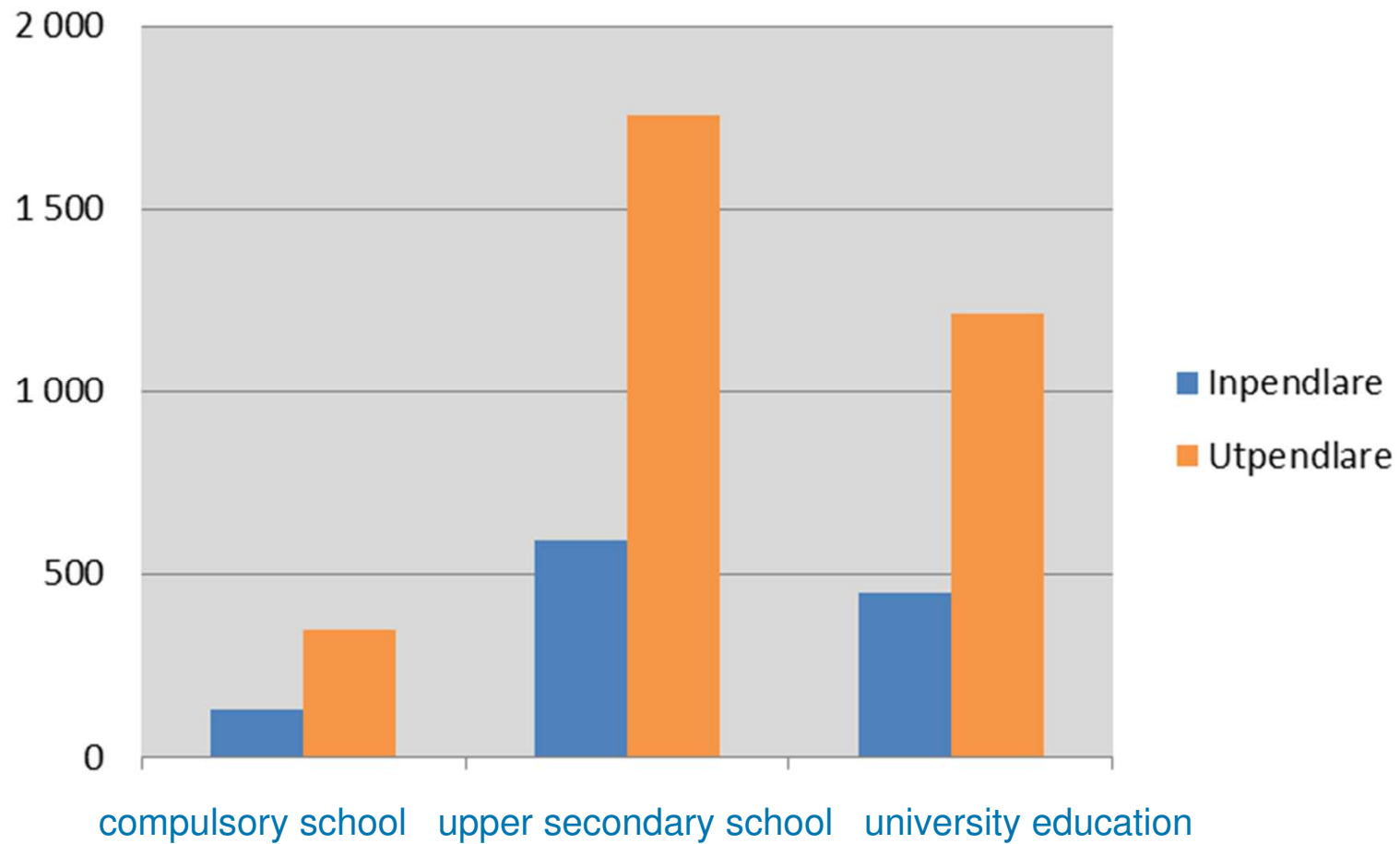


Moves to and from Orust

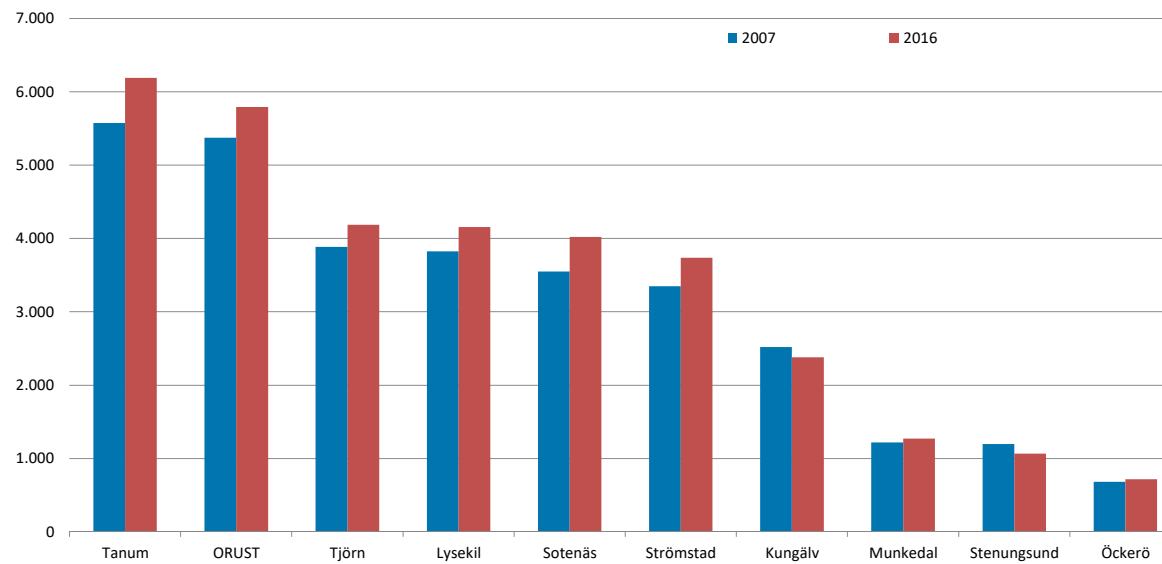
In- och utflyttade 1970-2016
